with puppy raising such as:

Common Puppy Woes

such as:

- Housebreaking, chewing, mouthing/nibbling, digging, counter surfing, barking, etc.
- Equipment changes – new leashes, capes, collars, and gentle leaders.
- Obedience skills – problem solving, additional clarification, etc.
- General behavioral troubleshooting.

Non-Emergent

medical issues such as:

- Sudden changes in behavior such as lethargy, not eating / drinking, frequent urination, excessive itching, etc.
- Recurrent vomiting / diarrhea.
- Routine visits for vaccines, heartworm prevention, flea and tick.
- Injuries / limping.
- Puppy eating foreign objects.
- Suspected allergies.

For immediate and Life-threatening emergencies:

Enter the emergency into Otto and then go to your nearest Emergency Veterinarian. Call ahead if possible to let them know you are coming.

Foster Puppy

issues such as:

- Requesting to foster a PAWS puppy.
- Information about upcoming litters or available puppies.
- Questions regarding Foster Puppy orientation, home visits, or placement.
- Questions, support, or concerns during the first few months with your new Foster Puppy.
- Aggressive behaviors towards dogs or people, bite incidents, resource guarding, etc.
- Changes in puppy housing situations.
- Concerns regarding welfare of dog within the household, as well as welfare of family members with the dog.
- Any situation where immediate intervention is warranted or required.
- Questions, information, or updates regarding Foster Puppy Turn-In.
